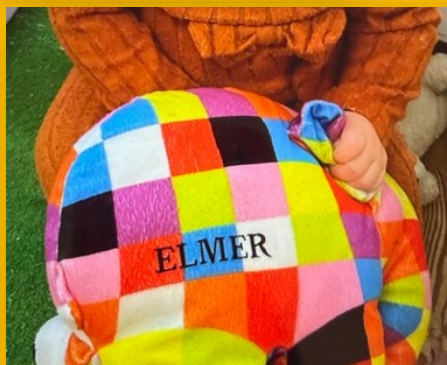
LITTLE EXPLORERS

The last week of our topic puddles and rainbows involved water play and Elmer.



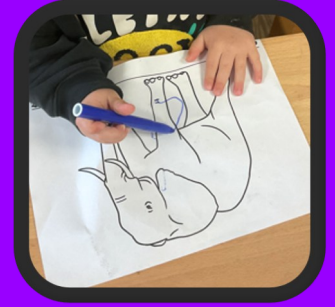
LITTLE DISCOVERERS

This week was our last week of puddles and rainbows. We explored water and Elmer.



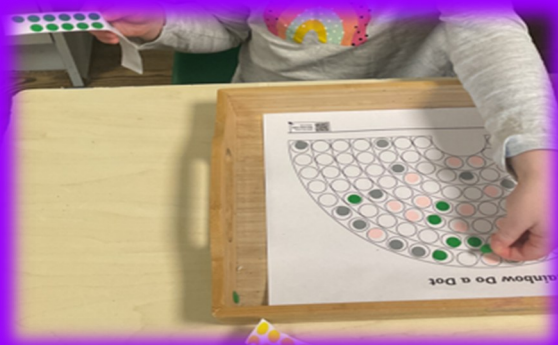
LITTLE WANDERERS

It was our last week of puddles and rainbows. We explored Elmer and the Rainbow



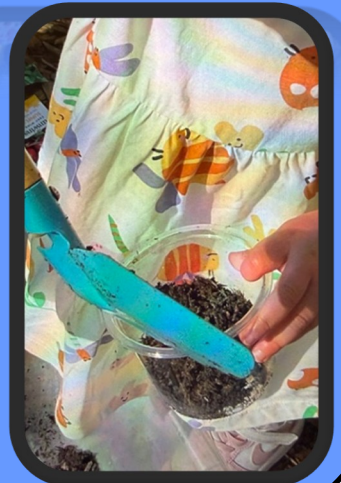
MONTESSORI IN ACTION
