We have been exploring rainbows. What lovely colours we have been looking at. We look at the story of 'The Colour Monster'



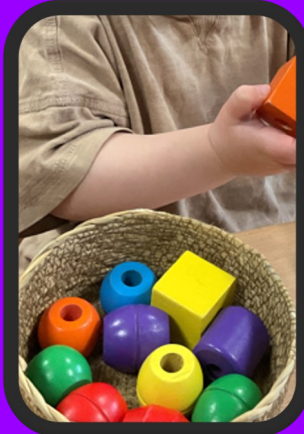
LITTLE DISCOVERERS

Voyagers have been exploring rainbows and the stories Colour Monster and Red Rockets & Rainbow Jelly



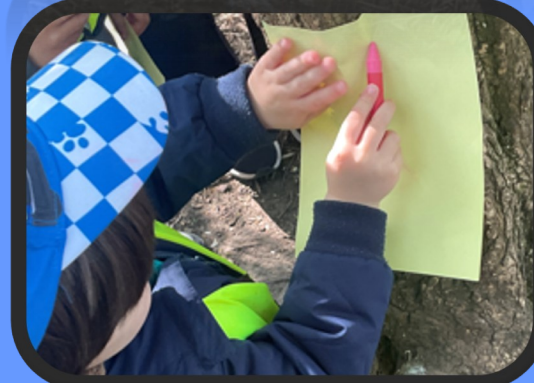
MONTESSORI IN ACTION

Children have continued their trips over to Forest School, exploring the environment.



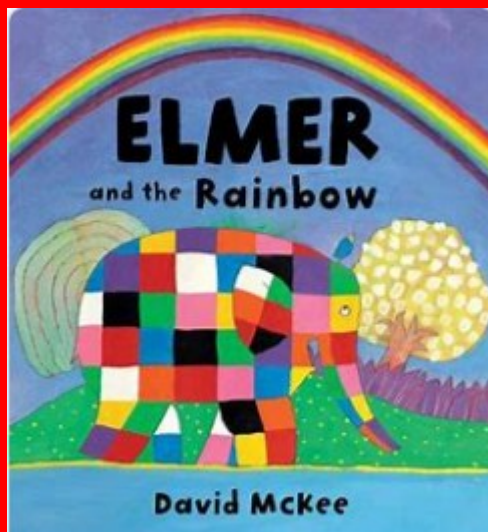


Themes and activities that we will be focusing on next week
