Montessori

The Montessori method emphasizes the development of the senses as a key part of a child's learning process. Montessori believed that children absorb knowledge from their environment through their senses. By engaging in hands-on, multi-sensory experiences, children enhance their ability to observe, categorize, and understand the world around them. This approach fosters independence, focus, and a deeper understanding of abstract concepts, as sensory experiences are seen as the foundation for intellectual growth.

Wow our Discoverers were treated to an explosion of sensory activity this week which they absolutely loved. They do love to get messy



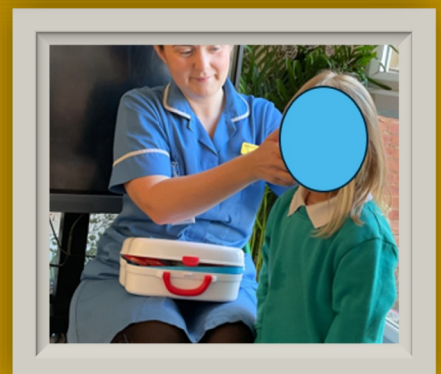
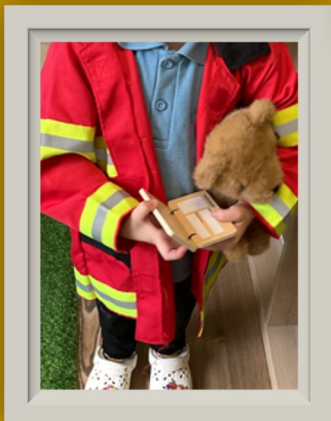
LITTLE WANDERERS

We reorganised the Voyagers classroom this week and they have enjoyed exploring it. Voyagers made friendship bracelets as part of our topic and met a real nurse.



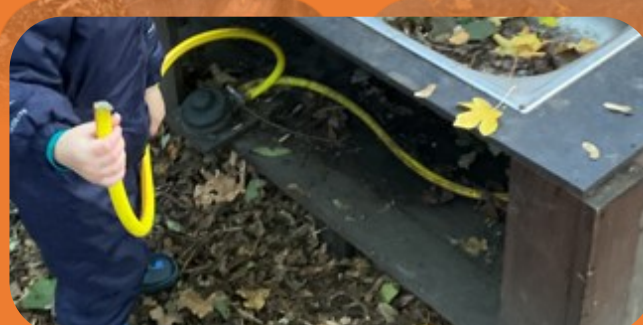
ANNA'S BAKING

Who can apply

Children born between 1 September 2021 and 31 August 2022 are due to start primary school in September 2026.

How to apply

You can apply from 1 November 2025. The deadline to apply is 15 January 2026.
