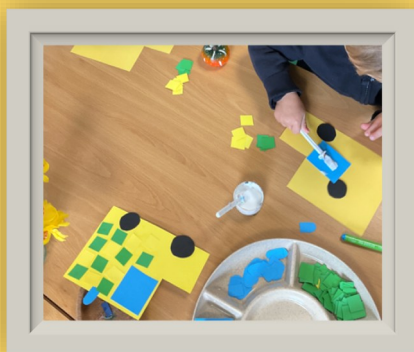
LITTLE WANDERERS

Children born between 1 September 2021 and 31 August 2022 are due to start primary school in September 2026.
