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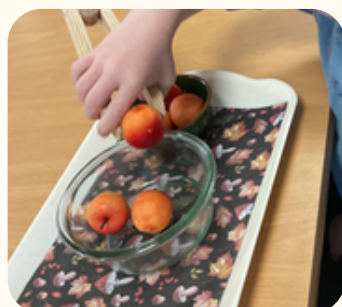

We do not take children into nursery who have been given calpol to control a fever before coming to nursery.

WANDERERS & VOYAGERS

Please note that in Wanderers room, our staff will do their utmost to greet your child on arrival, however if there are two or three children arriving at once, please note you may need to wait to be greeted or alternatively you can help your child settle yourself before having your greeting. New regulations mean that at least one and sometimes two people must be sat down at the breakfast table to watch children eat. It is no longer ok to just be in the room which may mean your keyworker is one of those people.



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
