Notices and Reminders

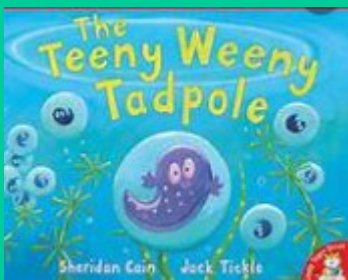
- If you are doing the home learning, please send your work in via the app or hand it to your child's key worker. We love to see what you do at home to support the learning in Nursery.

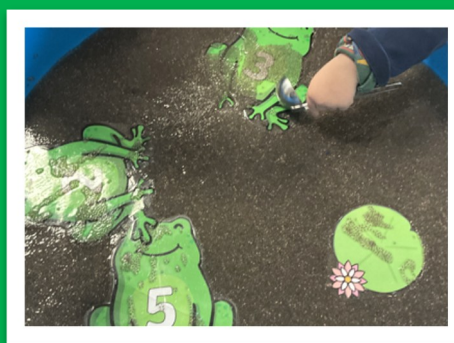
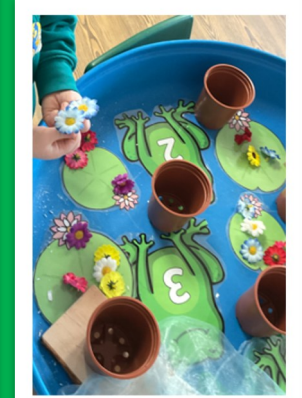
LITTLE DISCOVERERS

This week's skill for Discoverers was spreading. The children used a knife to spread onto their cracker



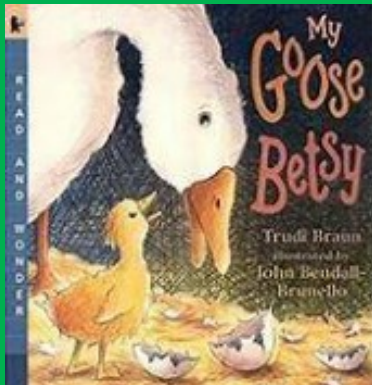


Explorers & Discoverers
