This week we looked at the story rhyme 5 little lambs. We also celebrated world book day with the story of the Hungry Caterpillar



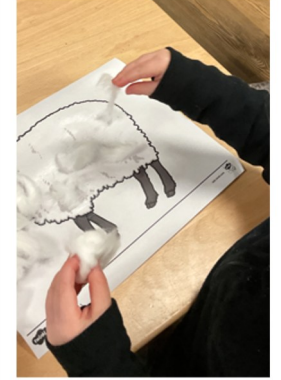
## LITTLE DISCOVERERS

## Themes and activities that we will be focusing on next week

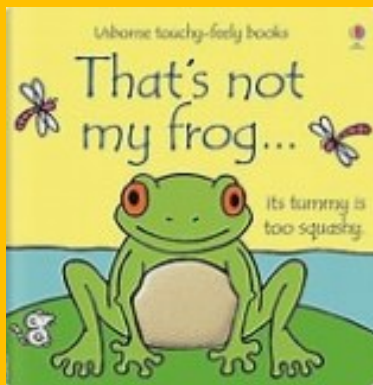


### Explorers & Discoverers

### POLICY INFORMATION

Heating food not cooked on the premises.

Did you know that if your child has a packed lunch, we cannot heat up anything within that packed lunch especially if you have cooked it. You can only send cold food for a packed lunch. The reason for this policy is that we are not in control of how the food was cooked, its ingredients, how it was stored and whether or not it has already been re-heated.

Under the Safer Food Better Business regulations, we must be in full control of how food that needs heating is handled from start to finish.
