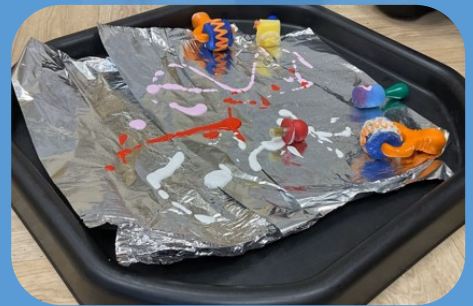
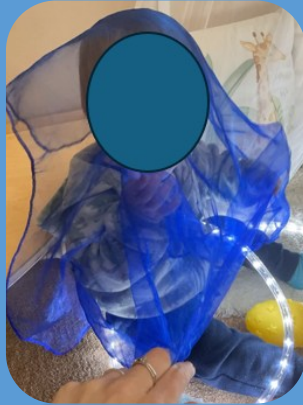
They are working on lots of skills including chopping, peeling, grating and others.

This week we looked at the story of 'Can't you Sleep Little Bear' and explored light and dark in our sensory room.



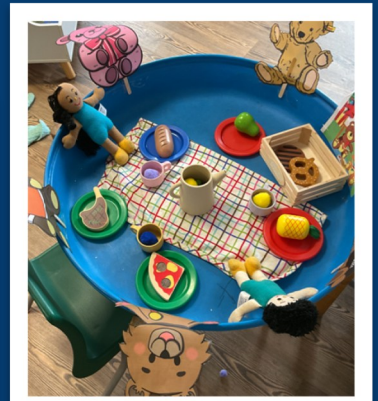
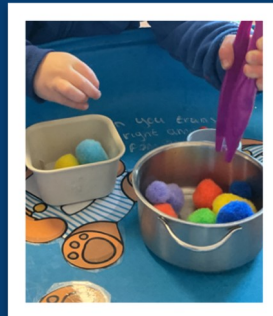
LITTLE DISCOVERERS

Voyagers explored the story 'Can't you Sleep Little Bear'. They played at putting the teddy bears to bed and patting them to sleep.



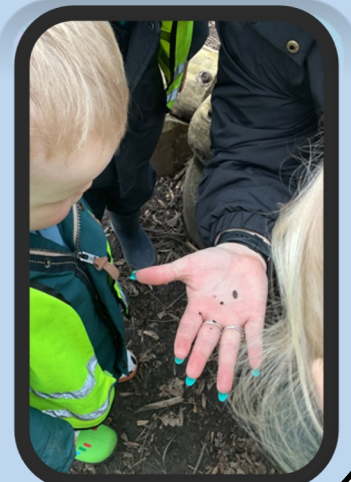
ACTIVITIES FOR EVERYDAY LIVING

Themes and activities that we will be focusing on next week

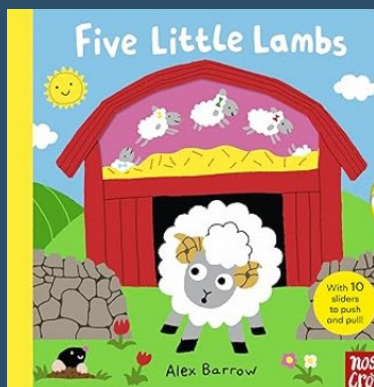


Explorers & Discoverers
